Israel-Gaza War: At least 20 people killed in strike on refugee camp in central Gaza, says hospital

In the early hours of Sunday morning, Al Jazeera Arabic's journalists on the ground reported Israeli raids in Rafah in the south of enclave and in the vicinity of the Kamal Adwan hospital in northern Gaza, where raids were also reported in the sheikh Zayed and Zeitoun neighborhoods.

Key events

At least 20 people have been killed and several wounded after an Israeli airstrike targeted a house belonging to the Hassan family in al-Nuseirat refugee camp in central Gaza, the al-Aqsa Martyrs hospital said on Sunday.

Witnesses said the strike occurred about 3am local time. Palestinian official news agency Wafa reported that several children were among the injured people, and that rescuers were searching for missing people trapped under the rubble.

Fierce battles and heavy Israeli bombardments have been reported in the central Nuseirat camp since the military launched an offensive on Rafah in early May.

United Nations: 800,000 people forced to flee Israel's offensive in Rafah

The United Nations said 800,000 people had been "forced to flee" Israel's offensive in Rafah, the southern city where hundreds of thousands of Palestinian civilians had sought refuge from Israeli bombardments. Israel's military says Hamas militants are located there.

"800,000 people are on the road having been forced to flee since the Israeli forces started the military operation in the area on 6 May", the Unrwa chief said on X.

Latest updates

- Two Israeli soldiers were killed in a battle in the southern part of the Gaza Strip, the Israeli military said on Sunday. It said airstrikes hit more than 70 targets across Gaza with ground troops conducting raids in eastern Rafah, killing 50 militants.
- Joe Biden's national security adviser Jake Sullivan met early on Sunday with Saudi Arabia's

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman to discuss what the kingdom described as the "semi-final" version of a wide-ranging security agreement between the countries.

- Hamas's armed wing, the Ezzedine Al-Qassam Brigades, said it fired a barrage of rockets towards Israel's port of Ashkelon and targeted an Israeli command centre at the Jabalia refugee camp in northern Gaza.
- In northern Gaza's Beit Lahia, witnesses reported airstrikes near Kamal Adwan hospital.
- Israeli war cabinet minister Benny Gantz demanded on Saturday that prime minister Benjamin Netanyahu commit to an agreed vision for the Gaza conflict that would include stipulating who might rule the territory after the war.
- Aid has begun entering Gaza via a temporary US-built floating pier. The Israeli army said 310 pallets began moving ashore in "the first entry of humanitarian aid through the floating pier". Satellite [sites de poker dinheiro real](#) showed more than a dozen trucks lining up Saturday on its approach road.
- British security firm Ambrey said on Saturday it had received information that a Panama-flagged crude oil tanker had been attacked approximately 10 nautical miles southwest of Yemen's Mokha.
- Austria said on Saturday it will restore its funding to the UN agency for Palestinian refugees (Unrwa) after suspending it over allegations that staff were involved in the 7 October Hamas attacks. A total of €3.4m (R\$3.7m) in funds have been budgeted for 2024, and the first payment is expected to be made in the summer, Austria's foreign ministry said in a statement.

Re revealed: UK supresión de críticas a los Emiratos Árabes Unidos por su presunta participación en el suministro de armas a milicias acusadas de limpieza étnica en Sudán

Funcionarios del gobierno del Reino Unido intentaron suprimir la crítica al Emiratos Árabes Unidos y su presunta participación en el suministro de armas a una milicia notoria que está llevando a cabo una campaña de limpieza étnica en Sudán, según han informado fuentes al Guardián.

Las afirmaciones de que los funcionarios del Foreign Office ejercieron presión sobre diplomáticos africanos para evitar criticar a los EAU por su presunta asistencia militar al Fuerzas de Apoyo Rápido (RSF) de Sudán intensificarán el escrutinio de la relación del Reino Unido con el estado del Golfo.

El RSF, un grupo paramilitar acusado de cometer crímenes contra la humanidad por organizaciones de derechos humanos, está sitiando la ciudad de El Fasher en Darfur, una región amplia en el oeste de Sudán.

Los combatientes han rodeado la ciudad, ante evidencia de que están apuntando y asesinando a civiles en base a su etnia. El sitio ha provocado advertencias de que si El Fasher cae, desencadenará una matanza a gran escala y un posible genocidio.

Posible acción legal contra los EAU

Yonah Diamond, un abogado internacional de derechos humanos, dijo que durante conversaciones informales este mes en Etiopía -para explorar la posibilidad de una acción legal contra los EAU por su presunta participación en la lucha- le dijeron diplomáticos africanos senior que el Reino Unido estaba desalentando activamente a algunos estados de condenar a los

Emiratos.

Las conversaciones de Diamond en Addis Abeba involucraron a funcionarios de la Unión Africana y la Autoridad Intergubernamental para el Desarrollo, un bloque comercial de ocho países del este de África, junto con otros diplomáticos.

Dijo: "Estábamos buscando construir apoyo para un mecanismo de protección civil [en Darfur] y movimientos para mantener a los EAU responsables en el Tribunal Internacional de Justicia u otra parte de la región".

Diamond, quien co-presidió una investigación independiente que encontró "evidencia clara y convincente" de que el RSF está cometiendo genocidio en Darfur, dijo: "Estábamos siguiendo las implicaciones de esos hallazgos, violaciones del [Convención de Genocidio] y la necesidad de que los estados cumplan con sus obligaciones".
